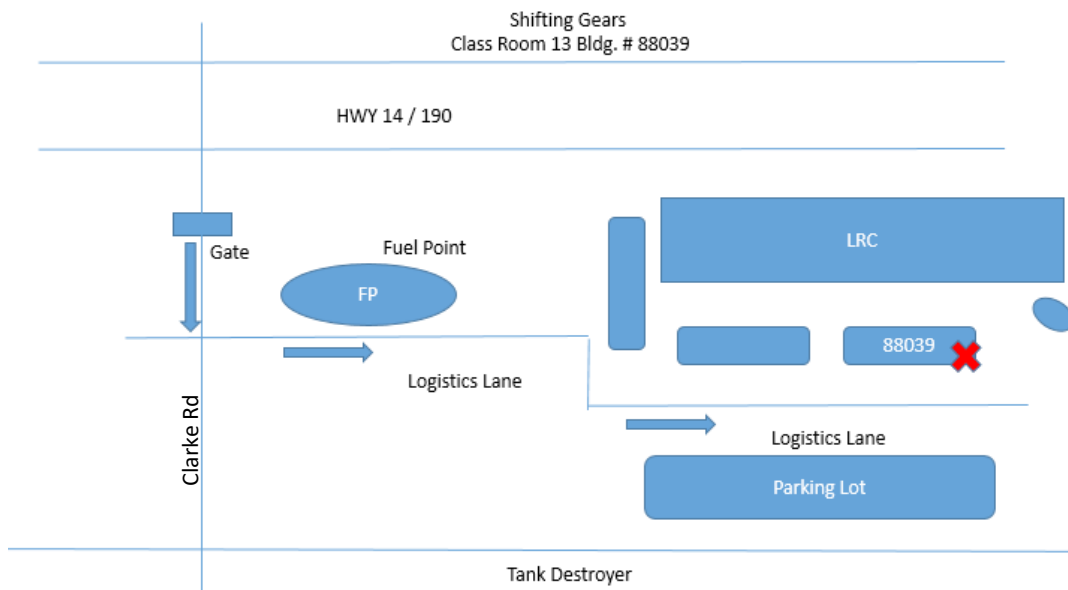

Execution Check List

1. Attend the Career Skills Program (CSP) briefing offered on Tuesdays at 1330 at The Copeland Center, RM B110.
2. At the end of the brief, Sign up for *Shifting Gears with the SFL-TAP personnel* to receive the packet.
3. Give the packet to Chain of Command for completion, and turn in the packet with the commander's signature to the Ed Center, RM G261.
4. Call Steve Bailey to schedule a facility tour, interview, and assessment any day Monday-Friday (except federal holidays) at Class Room 13 Bldg. # 88039.



5. Obtain a signed DA form 31 to have your terminal leave date count as your transition date.

NOTE: Steps 3 and 4 can be completed in either order.
